Contact

Telephone survey of Calgary residents 18 years of age and older with a total of 834 respondents



Field Dates

This survey was carried out between July 27, 2024 and August 20, 2024



Weights / Error

Survey results are weighted to age and gender, reflective of the population of Calgary

Margin of error is +/- 3.4%, 19 times out of 20




Key Takeaways

Here are the key takeaways from our Calgary survey


- If an election were held today, 43% of Calgarians would support Nenshi's NDP, while 41% would support Smith's UCP.
- Naheed Nenshi remains well-liked in Calgary, with 48% of Calgarians holding a favourable view of the former mayor. Another 30% have a negative opinion of Nenshi.
- Premier Danielle Smith finds herself underwater, with 47% of Calgarians holding a negative view of her, and only 29% having a positive opinion.
- Nearly half of Calgarians (49%) say that Nenshi would be the better choice to bring stability to Alberta, while 4-in-10 say that Smith is the better choice.
- Around 44% of Calgarians say they would be more likely to vote for the NDP with Nenshi as leader of the party, while 35% say it makes them less likely to vote for the NDP.



Question 1: If a provincial election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?















Question 2: Who did you vote for in the previous provincial election in May 2023?






Question 3: Do you have a positive, negative, or neutral opinion about Naheed Nenshi?




Question 4: Do you have a positive, negative, or neutral opinion about Danielle Smith?

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


Question 5: Which party leader would bring more stability to Alberta?

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


Question 6: Are you more likely or less likely to vote NDP with Naheed Nenshi as leader?
